



STRATEGIC DIRECTIVES

CARE

Through our survivor-led, trauma informed mentoring, support groups, retreats, recovery curriculum, emergency relief fund, and community partnerships, we help women heal from their past and rebuild their lives.

PROGRAMS

COST: \$373,000

OUTREACH

Continue to reach women and girls in strip clubs, porn, escorting, prostitution and victims of trafficking with the message that they are loved, valued, purposed and support is available.

STRATEGIC ACTIVITIES

- Monthly Strip Club Outreach to 47 clubs in Los Angeles County.
- Bi-monthly outreach to HIV testing centers for people in porn
- Strengthen our online reach through increasing our presence and visibility of resources in platforms where the women
- are interfacing.
- Engage in outreach to system impacted youth through retreats and workshops in partnership with DCFS, Department of Probations and Local Orgs serving youth.

COST: \$34,000

RECOVERY CURRICULUM

In January 2024, we will be officially launching Volume One of our Live Free Curriculum Series: Free to Thrive.

Survivor-developed, trauma-informed curriculum is hard to come by and so very needed. Based on the Stages of Change model and key resilience building blocks, Free to Thrive is designed for people in precontemplation and contemplation. It invites participants on a journey where they can explore their dreams and desires and ultimately begin to identify and eliminate the barriers they may be experiencing. In 2024, our goal is to finish developing the next Volume in the series.

COST: \$25,000

TRAINING

We will continue to offer our digital <u>training</u> in order to equip and empower allies, service providers and churches to effectively reach and support women in their cities who have been impacted by sexual exploitation and trafficking.

COST: FULLY FUNDED AND CREATING REVENUE

COLLABORATIVE RESEARCH PROJECT

In collaboration with three other Los Angeles-based non-profits providing services to women who have experienced exploitation and trafficking, Treasures is conducting a longitudinal study tracking survivor success in 14 different categories. We are utilizing data collected using the The Outcomes For Human Trafficking Survivors (OHTS) Instrument. The OHTS is an outcome evaluation instrument designed to help comprehensive service programs monitor progress toward outcomes among victims and survivors of human trafficking.

COST: FUNDED

OPTIMIZE OPERATIONS

In order to maximize efficiency and sustainability, we will engage in a process of optimizing operations.

ACTIVITIES

- Conduct comprehensive evaluations of current programs and projects to identify strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats (SWOT).
- Create comprehensive training/onboarding processes.
- Establish organizational continuity regarding reporting, tracking, filing and systems upkeep,.
- Evaluate and optimize current fundraising and development strategies.
- Evaluate staffing and organizational structure in order to identify potential gaps and needs

COST: \$30,000


IN LOVING MEMORY OF


Upon her passing, she gifted her entire estate to non-profits she believed in. Treasures was blessed to be one of them.

2023 INCOME \$479,028










FINANCIALS 2023 EXPENSE BREAKDOWN

Survivor of pimp-controlled exploitation turned UCLA honor student, in 2003, Harmony founded Treasures to help women and girls entrenched in sexual exploitation find freedom. She has provided training for the Department of Justice and the FBI and has helped train organizations in 139 cities worldwide. Her story has been featured on NPR, in Glamour, and in her memoir, Scars and Stilettos.
